<p>1. Can I make a claim for my personal losses / costs associated with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Lifestyle▪ Personal Effort▪ Mental Health▪ Loss of Use of my property	<p>No. The court-approved Claims Administration Procedure states that these types of personal loss / costs CANNOT be claimed unless identified explicitly in specified sections.</p> <p>Some examples that can be claimed include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Personal Time in the Flood Cleanup and Mitigation section.2. 50% Professional fees for an Independent Property Appraisal is included in the Property section.3. Agronomist Reports.4. Farmer Personal Travel Costs to / from Evacuated Animals.
<p>5. Shouldn't I be compensated for the time I could not use my property due to the 2011 Flood?</p>	<p>The court-approved Claims Administration Criteria and Procedure specifically states that loss of use <u>CANNOT</u> be claimed.</p>

6. Can I include these items in the Special Circumstances section of the Claims Administration Procedure?	<p>You may choose to file a claim for these items in the Special Circumstances section.</p> <p>However, as previously noted, the court-approved Claims Administration Procedure states these types of personal loss / costs <u>CANNOT</u> be claimed unless they are identified explicitly in specified sections.</p> <p>Further, the court-approved Claims Administration Procedure states it is at the sole discretion of the Claims Administrator what will be compensated from that section, who will follow all the criteria in the court-approved Claims Administration Procedure.</p>
